I was appointed as an Alabama State Trooper by the Alabama Department of Public Safety in 1976. I worked as a Trooper in three different locations across the State of Alabama. I was first assigned to routine patrol and during this time enforced the laws of the State of Alabama and investigated approximately 800+ traffic accidents involving motor vehicles on Alabama's highways. Approximately 75 of these accidents involved one or more fatalities.

In 1986 I was assigned to Alabama's first ever Motor Carrier Safety Unit under the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration's MCSAP program. As a Motor Carrier Safety inspector I conducted over 4,500 roadside inspections including all 5 levels of inspections, Hazmat and buses. I also conducted 50+ Safety Reviews for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration. I have served as an instructor at the Alabama Criminal Justice Training Center in Selma, Alabama and assisted with training, certifying and instructing state and local government officials and industry personnel on roadside inspections and CDL requirements.

In 2003 I was assigned to the Motor Carrier Safety Compliance Section. While in this Section I conducted 250+ comprehensive Compliance Reviews for the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration Alabama office. These reviews included freight haulers, Hazmat (shippers & Carriers), and bus companies. I also documented and made 80+ enforcement cases for the FMCSA Alabama office.
